We're a small, Island based, family business living just 45 minutes away from Cliff End, and we pride ourselves on offering a personal service for our guests so, if you think our bungalow is what you're looking for, then please complete and return this form so we can finalise your booking.

We are pleased to say that we think we've finally found an Island based company that will be able to offer generous discounts for ferry travel to the Island via WightLink through Portsmouth or Lymington. This is our first year of working with them and we believe their discounts will probably be better than others. Once we have your confirmed booking, we then send you Part 2 of the process with the necessary online link. If you need to look for Red Funnel discounts do try using the Island Guru link on the previous page.

Our bungalow sleeps 4 guests in 2 bedrooms. One room has a double bed and the other has two single beds. Unfortunately the site rules do not allow guests to bring their dogs, other than guide-dogs, and we ask our guests not to smoke in the bungalow.

Electricity is included in the rental charge. Dedicated highspeed 4G WiFi is also included as part of the rental charge with, all things being equal, download speeds in the region of 15Mb to 20Mb.

Also included in the charge is freshly laundered linen and the beds are made up for your arrival. Bath towels and hand towels are not provided, though we do provide a washing machine with an external rotary clothes line.

As well as the bungalow, an extensive grassed area may be used by guests enjoying superb views from all around the site; across to the Needles and over Hurst Narrows towards the Castle. The site has a children's play area, complete with football goal-nets, tennis nets, crazy golf and a wooden climbing structure.

Our bungalow sits on the edge of the King Charles III England Coast Path that goes around the Island's coastline and there is easy access to our family friendly beach.

The Island has a fascinating history with Royal connections and castles. It also has a remarkable range of scenery in a very small land area, rolling downland, sandy beaches, secluded creeks, and chalk cliffs. It's a great place for walkers with a huge variety of public footpaths, about 500 miles, taking you right away from the beaten track. To explore, visit:

For those of you who enjoy watching the 'night-sky', Cliff End offers a very good 'dark sky' experience.

Equally if you just want to sit and read, or paint, or simply chill-out, 68 Cliff End is a great place to be based. The Island is often called Dinosaur Isle, not because it's pleasantly old-fashioned, but because it's an extension of the Jurassic Coast and has a wealth of fossils for you to discover. There really is so much to do. Experience suggests you'll very quickly start to enjoy a more relaxed way of life.

The bungalow is cleaned and prepared between guests departing and the arrival of new guests. We ask that departures are made by 10.00am and arrivals are after 2.30pm so the bungalow can be prepared to the highest standard. We also hand over the keys to you in person and answer any last minute questions.
